

FDG Salmon Fly Course

Summer 01 - Crathie



Pattern / Materials

Hook Salmon Low Water Double #12 - #14 Silver (Fulling Mill Silver Magni Double)

Silk Black 8/0 or 12/0
Tag Oval Silver Small
Rib Silver Wire Small

Body Flat Holographic Silver Tinsel Medium Wing Black Squirrel Tail hair or Arctic Fox

Flash Micro Krystal Flash – Kingfisher Blue or Silver or Pearl

Beard Hackle Light Blue Cock or Hen Hackle or Fine Blue Hair

Cheeks Jungle Cock Eyes, small Head Black Thread & Varnish

Method

- 1. Tie in Black Thread 2mm behind eye and wind in touching turns towards bend.
- 2. Tie in Tag on top of shank and bind down towards bend, stopping above point of hook.
- 3. Wind 3-4 turns tag & return oval under between legs of hook, tie in and bind down surplus.
- 4. Tie in Rib under shank and bind down to bend.
- 5. Tie in Body Tinsel at bend and bind down to head.
- 6. Wind Body Tinsel in overlapping turns to behind eye, tie in and trim (can varnish under to secure).
- 7. Wind Rib in 4 or 5 open turns up body, tie in and trim, tidy thread to form flat base for wing.
- 3. Tie in Wing sparce about 1.5 times body length and trim off surplus. (Drop varnish on hair ends)
- 9. Tie in 2 strands Micro Flash to length of wing, double, cut off longer length and tie in
- 10. Strip small bunch of hackle fibres, tie in under shank with pinch & loop and trim.
- 11. Tidy up head thread over cut ends.
- 12. Tie in pair of small Jungle Cock Cheeks, fold back tie in and trim off.
- 13. Trim off surplus materials.
- 14. Wind thread to form neat bullet shaped head and apply coat superglue.
- 15. Apply clear or black varnish 2 coats, 24 hours apart.
- 16. Clean varnish out of eye of hook after each application!-----
