FDG Salmon & Sea Trout Fly Course

Alistair Tube



Materials

Tube 12.5mm (0.5") – 40mm (1.5") Plastic, Aluminium or Brass Tube

Thread Red Globrite #4
Tag Red Globrite #4

Body Gold Mylar Braid Tube OR Flat Gold Tinsel with Gold Oval Tinsel Rib

Flash Silver Krystalflash Wing Yellow Bucktail

Wing 2 Dirty Yellow / Brown Buck Tail

Flash 2 Pearl Flashabou Cheeks Jungle Cock Eyes

Head Fluoro Red Glo-Brite #4, Varnished

Hook Sleeve Fluoro Orange 3mm silicone

Hook Double or Treble #4 - #10 – works well with Gold coloured hook

Method

1. Mount tube in tube holder in vice

If using Braid Tubing body:

- 2. Varnish tube to stick braid tubing
- 3. Cut length of braid, slide onto tube, tie on Globrite at tail and secure braid by tying small tag. Whip finish and cut off waste.
- 4. Tie on thread at head and wind a couple of turns to secure.

If using Gold Tinsel & Gold Ribbing body:

- 5. Tie on thread and wind to create flat underbody
- 6. Tie in Oval Gold Rib
- Tie in Flat Gold Tinsel, take thread and wind up body, wind tinsel in overlapping tuns. Secure & trim waste
- 8. Wind Rib in open turns, secure & trim waste

Both types:

- 9. Tie on two strands of Krystalflash around tube, length to cover hook.
- 10. Select small bunch of Yellow Bucktail, stack to level ends, tie on tube, remove waste
- 11. Tie in three or four strands of Flashabou

12. Select small bunch of Dirty Yellow Bucktail, stack to level ends, tie on tube, spread around tube, remove waste

- 13. Tie in Cheeks
- 14. Form neat bullet shaped head.
- 15. Whip finish thread and varnish.
